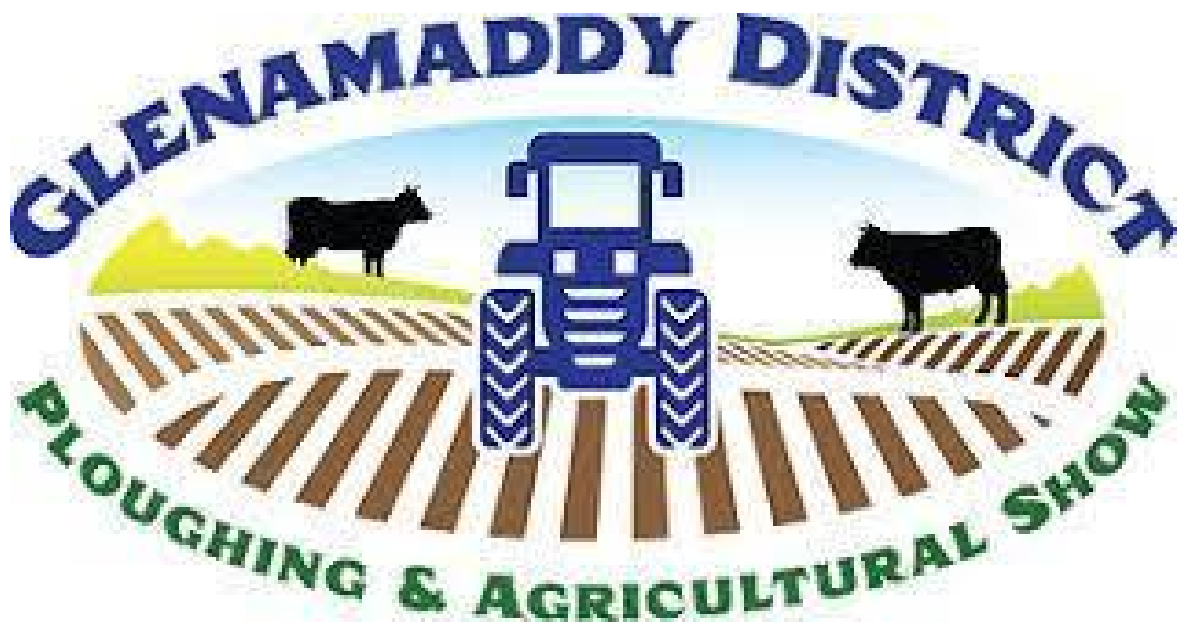

Important Information in respect of bovine animals for exhibitors at shows 2023.

The following Rules apply;

The movement of cattle to and from a show within the State must be recorded on AIM system. A Specific Certificate of Compliance for the movement of bovine from a single holding to a show must now be requested prior to the movement of animals concerned. These Certificates can be created by **(a)** applying online using their agri-food account or **(b)** where the keeper is not online the certificate can be generated by the local Regional Veterinary Office following receipt of a NBAS31K with issue available at the Departments Website. When applying for the certificate the destination Herd/Show number is not required. The certificate generated will be valid for 30 days. Calves under 10 days cannot be moved to a show. On show day the Certificate must be produced to the Show Secretary fully completed with cards.

EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE THEIR OWN CERTIFICATES OF COMPLIANCE WITH THEM ON SHOW DAY – NO CERT, NO SHOW

Testing requirements for movement of animals: **T.B.** All animals must come from herds, which are officially TB free (OTF) (i.e. not restricted) and the herd and relevant animals must have had a clear test within the previous twelve months – this test must be recorded on the Department's Animal Health Computer System (AHCS).

Identification: All cattle must bear two plastic tags with the same number (one in each ear) as issued under the Departments identification system. They must be accompanied by passports.

PLEASE NOTE: Classes may be amalgamated at discretion of committee if there are not sufficient entries.
